



Signaturit, wins award at the Fest-UP, the HandsOn Startup Tour and Generación

- *In November, Signaturit received a prize at the international entrepreneurs festival Fest-UP prize, won the HandsOn Startup European Tour competition and is one of the projects selected by Generación, the initiative to promote entrepreneurship by Deloitte and Cotec.*
- *The electronic signature solution exceeds the threshold of XXXX customers in their second year on the market. Furthermore, this year it has also completed a financing round with the participation of Banco Sabadell and ESADE BAN.*

15 DECEMBER 2015.- Signaturit, the Spanish technology company that enables companies and individuals to request legally valid electronic signatures through any e-mail service (including Outlook, Gmail and Hotmail) has collected three awards in one month, rounding off a successful year of the project led by Juan Zamora (CEO), Salvador Severich (CMO) and Javier Martinez (CTO).

The company, with offices in Barcelona and Amsterdam, won the Fest-UP award, a festival for entrepreneurs held in Barcelona last November. 300 startups participated at this event, but only 8 were able to pitch in front of a jury formed by representatives from Barcelona Activa, Carrefour and Barcinno, among other companies.

That prize allowed Signaturit to participate in the HandsOn Startup European Tour competition, in which 16 startups from 8 EU countries presented their projects to a panel of experts in Paris. In this occasion, the jury was formed by 5 seed investors and by executives from Microsoft and Carrefour.

Signaturit's easy and safe electronic signature solution caused the company to be one of the 8 that will have the opportunity to travel to Silicon Valley. There, it will have the opportunity to attend a program by a prestigious panel of investors, mentors and companies with which to establish contacts and partnerships.

This month Signaturit has also been one of the five projects recognized by the 4th edition of Generación, an initiative to encourage entrepreneurship promoted by the professional services company Deloitte and Cotec, a Spanish Foundation for Technological Innovation. The three founders of Signaturit received this award during a ceremony chaired by Cristina Garmendia, President of Cotec, and Fernando Ruiz, Chairman of Deloitte.

With respect to all this recognition, Juan Zamora, CEO and co-founder of Signaturit, comments: "these awards put a finishing touch to a 2015 that despite being only our second year in the market, has led to the consolidation of our project. Beyond all these distinctions, for which we are very thankful, 2015 has been the year of our first round of investment, which has allowed us to add partners as prestigious as Banco Sabadell



and ESADE BAN to our project, and the year in which we exceeded the threshold of 2.000 customers in more than 40 countries."
